The LearningExpress Library includes practice tests and electronic test preparation books for official exams such as the ACT, SAT, GED, ASVAB, Firefighter, Police Officer, Paramedic, EMT Basic, U.S. Citizenship, Postal Worker, Cosmetology, Real Estate Exams and more. LearningExpress also includes practice tests and e-books for people of all ages to improve their reading, writing, math and grammar skills.

Test takers get immediate scoring and detailed explanations of answers to all questions. Test results also indicate areas needing additional practice and include recommendations for free online tutorial courses that will help improve performance on subsequent tests.
