### PUBLIC REVIEW & INPUT SOUGHT FOR K-12 MATH TEXTBOOKS.

The math textbooks being considered for adoption by Clayton County Public Schools for grade levels K-8 will be on display at the Headquarters Library, Jan. 19- March 2, 2007.
